

ORDINANCE 1534-16

An Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 2, Liquor Control Regulations, of the Island Lake Village Code

WHEREAS, the Village of Island Lake is an Illinois municipal corporation in Lake and McHenry Counties and pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village has the authority to modify the official Village code;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees granted a Class A liquor license to Sam Desai, owner of Shrijala 2016, d/b/a Lakes Sports Bar, subject to an increase in the number of available Class A liquor licenses;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees granted a Class A. liquor license to Janet Lopez, owner of Tacos el Norteño, d/b/a El Norteño, subject to an increase in the number of available Class A liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to amend the provisions of the Island Lake Village Code regarding liquor control regulations to increase the number of available Class A liquor licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Lake, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Title 3, Chapter 2, Liquor Control Regulations, paragraph 3-2-4, Licensing Regulations, shall be amended as follows:

3-2-4 LICENSING REGULATIONS

* * *

E. Number Of Licenses Issued:

1. There shall be issued not more than a total of four (4) liquor licenses of class A.

SECTION 2: Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and approval.


