This letter officially recognizes and commends your community water system for maintaining perfect compliance in 2011 for 12 consecutive months in accordance with the state of Illinois fluoridation law (415 ILCS 40/7a) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 121g1) Public Water Supply Regulation Act.
