SUMMER CAMP AGENDA AND GUIDELINES

*Schedule is subject to change throughout the summer for various reasons. If field trip changes need to be made, we will try our best to inform parents ahead of time.

<u>FIELD TRIPS</u>: Most Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, will be our field trip days. The times posted on the calendar are when the bus leaves and when we are expected to arrive back at camp. Due to traffic or road construction our arrival time back to camp is an estimate. <u>We leave promptly at times posted. We do not call or wait for late campers to arrive.</u> <u>Please call the Club Phone when in question at 847.977.9147, not the Village Office please.</u>

<u>CAMP T-SHIRTS</u>: Each camper will receive a T-shirt and a Water Bottle. <u>We strongly</u> <u>encourage these to be worn on field trip days</u>. Extra shirts will be available for purchase half off the price we pay, and is strongly encouraged because of all the trips we do go on.

STAY AT CAMP/ACTIVITY/THEME DAYS: Two days a week we have more leisurely days hanging out at the Village Hall. Campers will do such things as crafts, sprinklers, water balloons, relax and watch a movie, play games, etc. Throughout the summer we will have theme days. We strongly encourage all campers to participate and bring donations to fit the theme. Sign-up sheets will be posted for these special days. Our counselors participate and we love seeing our campers get involved as well! Occasionally, we will walk to Converse Park and have a picnic lunch there and play on the playground and hill.

THREE OAKS RECREATION BEACH: When we are scheduled to go to Three Oaks Recreation Beach, the children will have to opportunity to purchase their lunch from the on-site Culver's. Campers are also welcome to bring their lunch from home this day too.

SPENDING MONEY: In addition to field trip fees if any, which will be listed on the schedule, your child may bring extra spending money to use at gift shops, concession stands, etc. We would like you to limit their extra money to \$10.00. Counselors are not responsible for your child's money! Children are not required to bring spending money. All field trips with the exception of 2 are included with your tuition. The other 2 will have an additional \$10.00 charge added to your weekly statement. Spending money

needs to be brought in separately. Please remind children when they do bring in money it is not to be shared with other campers.

<u>CHARGES</u>: Camp fees are expected to be paid weekly, if you are more than 2 weeks past due, in addition to a \$20 a week late charge, your child will be asked to leave camp until balance is paid.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP: Drop off and pick up will be at the Village Hall, behind the building where the Senior Center is located. It will be marked. If you are late there is an extra \$20 charge per day per incident. This will be strongly enforced since counselors do have other obligations to attend to after Camp.

TOYS AND ELECTRONICS: Although allowed, we strongly discourage bringing electronics and toys to camp. **Phones are not allowed** unless the parent requests their child to have it for parent/child contact only. We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken toys and electronics. If your child brings electronics, they will have limited time to use them and they will be put in our safe "Electronics Drawer."

DISCIPLINE AND SAFETY: We follow the same rules as Club. We expect our campers to respect one another and respect the counselors. If we have a discipline problem we will let the parent know. If it continues your child will be given a write up. If more than two write ups are necessary your child will be asked to leave camp. Safety is another major concern. We absolutely do not allow rough housing, wrestling, hitting, etc. While on the bus, children must be seated at all times and use quiet voices. Please let us know if your child has any allergies, especially this time of year for bee stings and asthma. If your child is allergic to bees or has asthma they must have an EpiPen or Inhaler with them at all times in their backpacks.

Please let us know if you EVER have any concerns or issues during your child's camp experience. No question or concern is ever too small to bring to the counselors or my attention. We would like to attack an issue as soon as possible. We are very excited to start camp and have a wonderful staff for camp this year, and we want this experience to be fun, exciting, and enjoyable for your child.

DAILY SUPPLY CHECKLIST

Campers are required to bring the following EVERYDAY to camp:

Backpack : Campers need to have a bag that closes and be able to carry by themselves with all of their supplies. Counselors will be carrying other
things and cannot carry the camper's bags as well.
Water Bottle : It is very important to stay hydrated when we spend so much time in the sun daily. We do have water fountains at the Village Hall to refil bottles.
Lunch : Make sure you send your child with a healthy lunch. We do have access to a microwave if needed. There will be special days that you will be notified ahead of time if a lunch is not needed.
Extra Snacks : We do provide a morning and afternoon snack. Sometimes that is not enough for your child's appetite. Feel free to send in an extra snack for your child, especially if they have certain dietary needs.
Swimsuit and Towel : There are many water activities that we do even if we don't go to a waterpark. Please make sure they are packed <u>daily</u> along with a plastic grocery bag to put wet items in.
Gym Shoes : Campers are not allowed to play on the playgrounds without gym shoes. Flip flops/sandals should be brought daily for waterparks and some of the other activities, but no camper will be allowed on the playgrounds with flip flops/sandals for safety reasons.
Spray Sunscreen: Counselors will apply the SPRAY sunscreen, but do NOT provide sunscreen for campers. If you prefer lotion than spray, we will
need written permission from you to apply to your child.
Socks : Please ALWAYS keep a pair of socks in the backpack. If it is rainy and we have to change our field trip, they may need them for another activity.

Please go over this checklist with your camper EVERY MORNING so they won't be left out of our daily activities.
