### Village of Island Lake Lake Management Committee August 1st, 2019 Minutes 3720 Greenleaf Ave. Island Lake, IL 60042

Present: Ken Wick, Patti Fugle, Kris Munson, Trevor Mock, Dave Sobieski and Tané Howland.

1. Meeting called to order at 6:30pm.
2. Motion made by Patti Fugle and second by Kris Munson to approve July 2nd, 2019 meeting minutes.
3. OLD BUSINESS
  - a. INFO: Lake Update. K. Wick – Dredge America is a company out of Missouri suggests obtaining a Hydrographic Survey of the lake bottom to determine the topographic map of the lake bottom and depth of 70 years of cubic sedimentation. Also with a sedimentation survey of the accumulated sedimentation basin contents. Once bids from three companies are obtained, it will be brought before the VOIL board of trustees. Finding companies with this specialty has been challenging and difficult for them to travel to Illinois to do a lake assessment, as most companies reside in coastal states. Dredge America would obtain needed permits and work directly with the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
  - b. INFO: Duckweed and algae update. K. Wick - A new weed control company proposed to change the lake's phosphate composition by adding aluminum. With no guarantees, raised committee members questions regarding unknown future ramifications by use of chemicals and impact on the fish population. At an estimated price of \$130,000. The committee opposes this option.
4. OTHER BUSINESS
  - a. INFO: Open for Members – Beaches are in need of maintenance, as they are growing grass. Beach maintenance falls under Parks and follow up with be done Trustee Ziegler, to see if this can be address. Duckweed is being trapped by the swim rope marker buoys and collecting in the swim areas.
5. NEW BUSINESS
  1. NEXT MEETING: Thursday September 5th, 2019 at 6:30pm.
  2. PUBLIC COMMENTS: Lake dredging, police presence and unsightly duckweed were discussed. Beach closings due to high E. coli level by the Public Health Department.
