ORDINANCE 1643-22

An Ordinance Amending Title 1 Schedule of Fees, Fines and Penalties and Title 3 Business Regulations of the Village of Island Lake Village Code

WHEREAS, the Village of Island Lake is an Illinois municipal corporation in Lake and McHenry Counties and pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village has the authority to modify the official Village code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Island Lake, Lake and McHenry Counties is a non-home rule unit of government; and

WHEREAS, Public Act (P.A.) 102-0689 of the State of Illinois allows non-home rule municipalities to impose an annual fee for the operation of each video gaming terminal not to exceed \$250 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Lake, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: 1-16-3 SCHEDULE OF FEES, FINES, AND PENALTIES: The license fee for operation of a video gaming terminal shall be \$150.00 annually and shall be added to the Schedule of Fees, Fines and Penalties of the Island Lake Municipal Code as follows:

3-5-7B 3 b	Video Gaming Terminal Fee, per terminal	\$150.00
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SECTION 2: Amend 3-5-7b 3 B of the Island Lake Municipal Code to read:

- b. The annual fee shall be due and payable upon application for issuance or renewal and shall be shared equally between the terminal operator and the applicable licensed establishment, per 230 ILCS 40/65. Licenses shall be for not longer than a one-year period from May 1 of each year to April 30 of each following year, unless sooner revoked or suspended. All licenses, regardless of date of issuance, shall terminate on April 30 of each year following the date of issuance. This fee is not in lieu of any fee or payment payable to the Illinois Gaming Board.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.


SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Where the provisions of this ordinance or any other Village ordinance establish or require different standards, the more restrictive standard shall apply.





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3-5-7B 3 b	Video Gaming Terminal Fee, per terminal	\$150.00
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SECTION 2: Amend 3-5-7b 3 B of the Island Lake Municipal Code to read:

- b. ~~Pays to the Village an annual fee of \$25.00 for each video gaming terminal upon the premises.~~ The annual fee shall be due and payable upon application for issuance or renewal and shall be shared equally between the terminal operator and the applicable licensed establishment, per 230 ILCS 40/65. Licenses shall be for not longer than a one-year period from May 1 of each year to April 30 of each following year, unless sooner revoked or suspended. All licenses, regardless of date of issuance, shall terminate on April 30 of each year following the date of issuance. This fee is not in lieu of any fee or payment payable to the Illinois Gaming Board.
