1. **Call to Order:** 6:35

3. **Approval of November 1, 2021 minutes:** Motion to approve by Eric Acevedo, second by Dave Sobieski.
4. **Public comment:**
Ed: 1) Fishing sign discrepancy regarding perch catch. Dave to confirm. 2) Port-a-potty location at Brier Beach and Veteran's will be unlocked for public use. 3) Lakeview bridge has signs and poles obstructing access under the bridge. Sgt. Gainer to investigate. 4) Policing the lake for illegal fish catch
5. **Committee Reports and Recommendations:**
 - a. **Parks Scorecard:** Newest Park Prairie Woods is in need of VOIL sign and a garbage can. Overall, much improvement of parks since the start of quarterly inspections.

Public Works Punch List: Eastway Park electrical wiring assessment. Converse Park sledding hill fencing a safety concern and to be repaired asap. Ice skating rink framing and will soon be open.
 - b. **Police Department/boat patrol/house numbers:** Sgt. Gainer reports that officers are now fully trained for boat and ice patrols. Main concerns for boat stickers, fishing licenses, downed trees in the lake which is a code ordinance. House numbers are required on the lake. Letter to go out to residence on the lake addressing seawalls, trees and house numbers.
