 3. **Approval of May 2nd, 2022 minutes:** Motion to approve by Tané, second by Dave.
 4. **Public comment:** Thank you for sending out the weedoo weed eater. Which is in need of repairs. Prairieland won't pick up raked seaweed in containers. Eastway needs a boat sticker required sign. DNR feels the lake is healthy right now. Carp chum with corn two weeks prior to Carp Fest but too many weeds.

5. **Carp Fest Planning:** Planning close to completion registration forms completed. Shirts to arrive 6/8, Prize collection numerous gift card, Lions club donated 20 free kids fishing poles (first come first served). Boater must have VOIL boat sticker, fire extinguisher and life vests. Police department will be out on their boat.
 6. **Baxter & Woodman Planning:** No recent contact from them.
 7. **ILM Lake Management Planning:** Lake assessment on going.
 8. **Lake Treatment update & June Plan:** Focus on main part of lake, beaches and boat launch. Shorelines to be addressed.
 9. **Aerator Update:** Placed at Little Island Bay and one will also be placed Channel after ComEd installs power box.
 10. **Fish Crib Update:** 18 cribs have been placed and several more to go in.
 11. **Website Update:** 86 survey responses will review next meeting.
 12. **Eastway Parking Expansion & BAAD Grant:** Julie has marked the Eastway boat launch for gravel parking area, to be completed before the Carp Fest Event. Four semi loads of gravel harvested from the VOIL road resurfacing. IDNR offers a 100% grant for Boat Access Area Development Program (BAAD) for new construction of boat launching area. Kayak launching areas and Lattice construction parking that allows for water absorption discussed. Deadline September 1st, 2022. First letter drafted; mission statement needs to be added. Will have VOIL Attorney Dennis to review all documents before sent out.
 13. **All-Abilities Playground Strategy & Planning:** Three bids will be obtained. Funding \$180,000 from Illinois State Senator Dan McConchie. Dermatology grants for sunshade park structures for kids. Tané to explore American Academy of Dermatology for grants.

New Business: No new business.

14. Public Comments: Mesh grates over storm drainage pipes in need of grate replacements covers, as racoons are now using them. Donated Bass Pro Shop gift cards from Patty Waugh, for Carp Fest. If a boat breaks down on the lake is there an emergency number to call.
