I do hereby fully release and discharge the Village of Island Lake and its officers, agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims resulting from injuries, damages, and losses sustained by me or by my child/ward, and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of any of the program(s). I understand that there may be times when my child/ward and/or I will be photographed. These photos may be used for decorating Village of Island Lake bulletin boards or for other publicity purposes, as well as in the Village newsletter, Facebook or Website and I give my permission for this. Trunk-or Treat Rules 2022

1. All treats must be individually wrapped. By submitting a registration, the trunk owner acknowledges that all treats are subject to inspection. No homemade treats are allowed.
2. Vehicle must arrive at the Village Hall of Island Lake parking lot on October 22 no later than 5:00 p.m.
3. All trunks must be decorated and staffed by 5:55 p.m. – the event begins at 6:00 p.m.
4. Electrical support will not be available.
5. All Trunk Registrations must be submitted to Island Lake Recreation Department by Monday, October 10, 2022.
6. Only those who have properly registered their vehicles by Monday, October 10, 2022 will be allowed to participate at this event.
7. Registered vehicles must stay at the event until the event ends at 8:00 p.m. For safety purposes, vehicles will not be allowed to leave the parking lot until the event is over.
8. Vehicle must be attended by an adult at all times.
9. Participants should be aware that children of all ages are expected to attend this event.
10. Businesses and organizations are allowed a single banner or sign advertising their business or service.
11. No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
12. Cars must be turned off for the duration of the event.
13. No open flames, fireworks, flammable liquids, etc.
14. All decorations must be contained within your own parking space.
15. Parking spaces will be pre-assigned prior to the event.
16. One spot equals one vehicle.
