Dear Property/Homeowner:

Over the next several weeks, AT&T crews and our contractors will be working in your neighborhood to expand our fiber network. Sometimes this work will require access to existing pedestals, utility poles or other structures. These structures are located within easement or public right-of-way.

AT&T will always do its best to avoid disruption to services and minimize disturbance to the surrounding landscaped areas. Although some of these areas of ground will need to be disturbed, we will work to reduce the duration of opened pits, placement of equipment and take the necessary precautions to ensure there will be no unguarded hazards. All disturbed areas will be restored to original or better condition. Final restoration will commence once all work has been completed.

Approved permits have been granted by the local permitting agencies. Locates will be called out prior to the start of work.
