Lake Treatment and Fireworks Funding: 2025 Update



At the May 7th meeting, the Trustees agreed to hire a new company to care for our lake. While the cost is higher than originally anticipated, we believe this company has the expertise and integrity to manage the lake responsibly and effectively. Unfortunately, previous year's treatments did not deliver the results we had hoped for.

Our lake is a central part of our community, and its health—as well as the safety of residents who enjoy swimming, fishing, and boating—remains one of our highest priorities.

To help offset the increased expense for lake treatment, we made the decision to have the fireworks publicly funded this year by donations.

Mayor McLaughlin was recently contacted by a company interested in putting on a fireworks display for our village. However, as noted above, the village will not be covering the cost this year. Instead, we will be accepting donations from those who wish to help make the display possible.

The minimum cost for the display is \$5,000. The more we are able to raise, the larger and more impressive the show can be.
