## Ordinance No. 1716-25

### ***An Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 2, Licensing Regulations and Chapter 5, Gambling and Gambling Devices of the Village of Island Lake Code***

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to amend Chapter 2, Title 3, of the Liquor Control Regulations of the Village Code, to address the maximum number of liquor licenses authorized to be issued by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to amend Chapter 5, Title 3, of the Liquor Control Regulations of the Village Code, to address the maximum number video gaming licenses authorized to be issued by the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Island Lake, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 3-2-4 of the Village Code shall be amended, in part, as follows:

#### **3-2-4 LICENSING REGULATIONS**

E. Number of Licenses Issued:

1. There shall be issued not more than a total of five (5) liquor licenses of Class A.
2. There shall be issued not more than a total of seven (7) liquor licenses of Class B.
3. There shall be issued not more than a total of zero (0) liquor license of Class C.
4. There shall be issued not more than a total of three (3) liquor license of Class AA
5. There shall be issued not more than a total one (1) liquor License of Class A(1).

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SECTION 2: Section 3-5-7 of the Village Code shall be amended, in part, as follows

#### **3-5-7 GAMBLING AND GAMBLING DEVICES**

E. Number of Licenses Issued: There shall be no more than a total of eight (8) video gaming. Licenses shall be approved by the Mayor with the consent of Village Board.

F. Eligibility: Class A and Class AA liquor license holders will be eligible to apply for a video gaming license only after completion of six (6) months of continuous operation as determined by the Mayor in his exclusive discretion.

G. Violation and Revocation: If a licensee violates any provision of the Video Gaming Act or any provision related to video gaming terminals contained in this Section, such violation shall be deemed a violation of the licensee's liquor license and subject to all penalties and restrictions for a liquor license violation, as well as this Section. In addition, a violation of this Section or of any ordinance pertaining to the

conduct of such business may result in the revocation of the licensee's video gaming terminal license issued by the Village, and the Village may report any violations to the Illinois State Gaming Board or other appropriate regulatory agency.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Where the provisions of this ordinance or any other Village ordinance establish or require different standards, the more restrictive standard shall apply.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.




